Summer Camp Revised Plan: 4 – 11-year-old students:

Summer is an excellent time for students to enhance their foundations of Islam, while integrating the fundamentals of reading, writing and math. To provide them with a sense of change, some of these summer camp activities will be taking place outdoors, weather permitting. Students will be divided into different groups based on their age level. They will be participating in these activities in whole groups or in small groups. Our summer camp staff are experienced teachers, working under certified administrators. So, take advantage of this beneficial time and register your students today! Although other summer camp programs are available in the area, Islamic Foundation School's facility is distinct based on its strategic location, cleanliness and resources.

Each day will consist of the following exciting activities, which were created by two of the camp instructors, Muryem Quadri and Fatimah Totten.

- **Arrival** through door number 10 at 9 a.m.
- **Light of Islam:** Students will be learning concrete information about deen through hadith, duaa, and various stories of the prophets. They will be reciting duaa's and simple calligraphy to strengthen and cultivate Arabic language and writing skills. They will also be reading relevant books and learning basic history that teaches campers about the numerous innovations that have emerged in terms of math, architecture/art, and exploration through Muslim figures and thought.
- **Prophetic Projects:** Students will be using STEM, outdoor activities, and team-building competitions to kinesthetically allow the stories and overarching themes of prophet stories to permeate into campers. This will be a fun and exciting way for them to collaborate with one another and apply critical thinking skills.
- **Living Islam:** Craft take-home art that reinforces Islamic knowledge learned together will be a focus of this activity. This will breakdown complicated or abstract doctrine and make it palpable for campers as they create their own connections through tangible projects that can be utilized beyond camp.
- **Snack Time:** All campers should come prepared with a hearty snack and bottle of water to have energy for the day. Etiquettes and Islamic mannerisms will also be a focus during this time-period.
- **Loving Islam:** This session will involve group discussions and activities that aim to foster love of Allah through recognizing all of His creation. Daily reflection in journals to encourage children to personally actualize the theme of the day and find an age appropriate way to apply it to how Allah (swt) has provided for them in their own lives.
- **Dismissal** through door number 10 at 1 p.m.
- **Before/After School Care Option:** \$10 per hour will be charged from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4 p.m.
